The Scholarship Committee:

The scholarship committee is made up of at least 4 members, no more than 5 members who will decide the recipients. The committee chair will facilitate the application, review and award process and contact scholarship committee to review the applicants before reunion.

The scholarship committee must be a family member that has participated and attended Family Reunion Conferences. Also, the five member scholarship committee should not be all from one particular state and there should be no more than two members from the same state.

A new scholarship committee can be selected at each reunion unless the Family Reunion body decides to keep the same committee.

The scholarship committee will judge and evaluate all applicants who meet requirements.

The scholarship committee reserves the right not to grant any scholarship.

The scholarship committee reserves the right to grant the scholarship amount that is given to each recipient.

The scholarship committee will establish a bank account for the scholarship fund in the name of the Anderson, Robinson, Wells and Wilson Family. Any donations for the Reverend Dr. Clyde A. Anderson Memorial Scholarship should be made payable to the Anderson, Robinson, Wells and Wilson Family and noted for the Reverend Dr. Clyde A. Anderson Memorial Scholarship.

The scholarship committee should be able to initiate a fund raiser for funds at the family reunion or other family gatherings.

The scholarship committee should be able to also solicit donations from family members and outside institutions, organizations and or/business sources.

The awardee(s) of the Reverend Dr. Clyde A. Anderson Memorial Scholarship will be announced during the upcoming reunion at the Family Banquet. The scholarship funds will be awarded/dispersed during the first week of the Fall Semester in August.

The awardee(s) are strongly urged to attend the Family Reunion Conference/Banquet, but if not able to attend for some pertinent reason, a parent or legal guardian may accept. The awardee(s) must notify the scholarship committee chairperson if this occurs within 10 days of the Family Banquet.

The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the committee. The scholarship amount will be based on the funds available and the number of eligible graduates.
